COVID-19 Safety Procedures

Renewal Main Line will start providing childcare during service for children **ages 4 years and below**. Childcare will not take the place of the 9am Children's Ministry virtual lessons, which will still be held for this age group. Please read and follow these important procedures and policies that we are implementing to re-open as safely as possible to protect our children, families, and volunteers.

Before service, please get a name tag for your child on the table by the entrance and put it on them before childcare (put it on the backs of 0-2 year olds).

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- All volunteers are vaccinated and will be masked at all times. Their temperature will be taken prior to serving.
- All volunteers will have their proper clearances prior to serving.
- All children ages 2 and up are to wear masks during childcare.
- No snacks or drinks will be permitted or provided during childcare. Please feed your child a large breakfast before childcare.
- Hand sanitizer and tissues will be available in each classroom.
- A HEPA air filter will be run in each classroom during childcare.
- If your child or family member has a positive Covid case, please notify us immediately so that we can perform contact tracing. We will notify other parents in your child's class so they can start their 10 day quarantine period.

DROP OFF/PICK UP

- Children will be dismissed from the worship service during the greeting time.
- Masked parents may drop off their children directly to their classrooms:
**Nursery children 0-2 years old are on the 3rd floor and
Preschool/Pre-K children 3-4 years old are on the 2nd floor.**
- All children will have their temperature taken during the sign in process. Any child with a temperature of 100°F or higher will be asked to sit with their parents in service.
- Before entering the classroom, parents will sign in their children on the attendance sheet.
- Masked parents are asked to **pick up their children immediately after service**, before fellowship time, to be respectful of the volunteers' time.

NURSERY [0-2 YEAR OLDS]: 3rd FLOOR CLASSROOM

- The church playmats will be set on the floor and the church toys will be divided and set up separately from each other to try to spread the children out as much as possible.
- All church playmats and toys will be sanitized after each use before being put away.
- Parents may opt to bring their own bag of toys and blanket/playmat for their child to play with/on instead of using the church's toys/playmats. All items should be labeled with the child's name and given to the volunteer during drop off. The items **will not** be sanitized when they are returned.

PRESCHOOL/PRE-K [3-4 YEAR OLDS]: 2nd FLOOR CLASSROOM

- Floor dots will be set up 6 feet apart from each other on the classroom floor so that children sit in their own area.
- Each child will have their own personalized supply bag (crayons, scissors, glue stick) and clipboard as a work surface to do their craft or activity. These supplies will not be sanitized after each use as they will only be used by the child whose name is on the bag.
- If weather permits, the children may be taken outside to play. At this time, children and volunteers are required to wear masks outside as well.
- Children will be reminded to sanitize and wash their hands frequently.
